

## **PART-TIME TEMPORARY STAFF ATTORNEY**

### **Anchorage**

Alaska Legal Services Corporation seeks a part-time attorney for its allotment unit in Anchorage, for a three-month period, 20 hours per week, to start as soon as can be arranged. The position includes representation of Alaska Native allotment applicants or their heirs to get their allotment applications approved and certified. This includes representation during adjudication by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), appeals of BLM decisions to the Interior Board of Land Appeals, hearings before Administrative Law Judges, and appeals to federal court. It also includes legislative and administrative advocacy. Rural travel is required.

Two or three years experience is preferred. Applicants must be admitted to practice in Alaska or be eligible for an Alaska Bar Rule 43 waiver.
